## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF RISK

Acting as the guardian of the child(ren):

I acknowledge and accept the following:

### **1. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF RISKS**

The signatory and the participant recognize that the practice of a downhill snow sport involves inherent risks that he/she must be aware of, regardless of the Instructor's level of supervision and the student's skill level. They accept the risks and assume full responsibility for any material or physical damage resulting from said risks. The risks inherent to the practice of a downhill snow sport include, but are not limited to, the following:

- changing weather conditions;
- changes in the steepness of the slope;
- the presence of natural obstacles and the conditions on the mountain. Any natural condition on the mountain, such as the presence of pits, crevasses, and streams, the presence of rocks, soil, surfaces without snow, the presence of trees, tree regrowth, natural shrubs, and stumps, as well as any other natural obstacle;
- the presence of ice and ice patches;
- any change in the conditions of the skiing/snowboarding surface;
- any collision with another skier or any other person;
- the presence of and collision with pylons, posts, and other structures used in the operation of the station;
- the use of lift facilities;
- the presence on the trails of mobile trail maintenance equipment, emergency vehicles, as well as snowmaking equipment.

For a safe and rewarding experience, you must respect the mountain's code of conduct at all times and show courtesy towards others. You must comply with any other rule and sign posted or otherwise indicated by the resort. Be careful and respect the code. It's your responsibility!

### **2. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT**

The student is responsible for following the instructions and applying the instructor's teachings.  
The student has the responsibility to respect the signage and act safely.

### **3. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN/PERSON RESPONSIBLE or PARTICIPANT**

The parent/guardian/person responsible or participant must ensure that the student's ski or snowboard equipment is appropriate, safe, in good condition, and checked regularly. The Snow School recommends wearing a protective helmet.  
The parent/guardian/person responsible or participant has the responsibility to inform the school and the instructor of any pre-existing medical condition the student may have that could affect his/her skiing or snowboarding and impact the inherent risks of these sports.  
The parent/guardian/person responsible or participant must be on time for the beginning of each lesson. It is not possible to make up for the lost time.

### **4. SUPERVISION**

I acknowledge that skiing and snowboarding take place over a large area, which means that the instructor is not close to his/her student(s) at all times and that he/she cannot directly intervene at all times.  
The instructor cannot maintain visual contact with his/her students(s) at all times.

### **Snow lessons (group)**

During a snow lesson, the instructor's attention is divided among the students, and he/she cannot supervise a particular student at all times; During a snow lesson, the student may need to take the chairlift without his/her instructor seated next to him/her (coordinate seating upon arrival at the lift facilities);

### **6. RULES**

This contract is subject to the governing laws of the province of Quebec. Both the Signatory and the Issuer agree to choose the judicial district of the ski resort in the province of Quebec as the exclusive forum for any claim whatsoever arising out of this contract.

Cancellation Policy:

Packages and private lessons:

- No refunds, changes, or cancellations less than 24 hours before the lesson.
- We strongly advise you to check the weather conditions for the desired date before booking.
- If the student is late, the class cannot end later than the initially scheduled time.

Group programs:

- No rescheduling of lessons is allowed.
- The *Consumer Protection Act* applies. The refund will be made in proportion to the services provided, minus 10% for service fees. The calculation will be done according to the date on which all documents will have been received.

In the event the lesson card or ticket is lost, one duplicate will be provided, the cost of which is 30\$.

### **7. HEALTH INSTRUCTIONS:**

All persons registered for the various lessons offered agree to respect the measures in effect at the time of their visit to the resort. These measures are indicated on the resort's website.
